



In Cook County, the **largest industry for employment is business**, which aligns with industries that MKE fellows go into for their first 2 years.




- Management, business, science, and arts occupations




Findings from K-means clustering model: MKE Fellows should target their expansion efforts to high poverty, high employment, large urban areas.





Agglomerative clustering shows us that Cook County is an outlier with **high poverty rate** yet an **average median income**, making it a target.
